

INSTRUCTIONS IN TRAVELLING FROM NINOY AQUINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (MANILA) TO BAGUIO CITY

From Airport to Victory Liner Bus Station:

From Airport, ride an airport taxi going to Victory Liner Bus Station, Pasay City. Ride usually costs around Php 150.00 (3 USD) or more depending on the intensity of the traffic.

There is also an express bus from airport terminal going to Victory Liner, Pasay City which also costs Php 150.00 (3 USD) but time of pick up may vary. The time travel may also be longer than when you ride an airport taxi as the bus has specific route to pass to get to the destination. You can book or inquire through their website <u>https://booking.ubeexpress.com</u> (select Grand Prix route for booking or click menu for their contact details)

From Victory Liner Bus Station to Baguio City:

In the bus station, you can buy your ticket in the ticketing office and find the suitable schedule/time of departure. A ride from Pasay to Baguio City costs around Php 500.00 (10 USD) for a regular air-conditioned bus and Php 750.00 (15 USD) for a first class/deluxe bus. Regular air-conditioned bus departs the station every hour while first class bus has a random schedule.




You can check <u>www.victoryliner.com/TerminalGuide.aspx</u> to know the schedules (From: Pasay City To: Baguio City). You can also inquire or book a ride online through their website (<u>www.victoryliner.com</u>). Just make sure to allot extra time for the possible delays in flight and your travel period from the airport to the bus terminal when booking online.

From Baguio City Victory Liner Bus Station to Hotel Supreme:

Once you arrive at Baguio City Victory Liner Bus Station, you can ride a taxi going to the hotel which will cost you roughly about Php 100.00 (2USD) or more depending on the traffic.

From Airport to Baguio City:

Riding a taxi from airport to Baguio City usually costs Php 5, 000.00 - 7,500.00 (100-150 USD). This may sound convenient to some however; it is quite hard to book a taxi that will consider this travel. It is also more advisable to ride a bus rather than a taxi when going to Baguio City.
